S G Petch ANECCC Stage Rally Championship

COMPETITOR REGULATIONS:

1. The Association of North East & Cumbria Car Clubs (ANECCC) will promote a Special Stage Championship for the 2010 season consisting of the events listed in regulation 15. The Championship is to be known as the 'S G PETCH ANECCC Stage Rally Championship'. From now on throughout these regulations the ANECCC Stage Rally Championship will be known as "the Championship".
2. The Championship will be held under the general regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations, and written instructions issued by the Championship Coordinator and any written instructions that the organising clubs of the individual events may issue.
3. The MSA Permit waiver number is 5/2010.
4. The Championship will consist of 13 rounds. 7 of the 13 rounds will count towards the competitors overall and class score. In the event of counting rounds being cancelled the number of counting scores will be as follows:-

5. Competitors must start 4 rounds to be eligible for an award.
6. The championship registration fee is £10.00 each per driver or co-driver. All cheques should be made payable to **ANECCC STAGE RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP**. It is not necessary for both crew members to be registered for the Championship. **ALL REGISTERED CONTENDERS MUST BE MEMBERS OF A CLUB, CURRENTLY A MEMBER OF THE ASSOCIATION OF NORTH EAST AND CUMBRIA CAR CLUBS**. The Championship Promoters reserve the right to ask competitors to produce full membership cards for a current ANECCC club at anytime throughout the Championship.
7. A list of registered contenders will be supplied to clubs organising rounds of the Championship. However, the onus is on the competitor to ensure that they receive the event regulations and an entry is submitted to the organisers before the stated closing date for entries. No guarantee of acceptance of entry is made by the event or championship promoters. Registered contenders will automatically be eligible to score points once they have started an event, "Starting" shall be deemed as passing the first time control of the event.
8. Any car carrying a registered contender **MUST** carry 2 championship decals, one on each side of the car, throughout the event for which they wish to claim points. Spot checks will be made throughout the year. These decals will be issued to each contender when they register and a supply will normally be available at signing on for each event. It is the responsibility of the contender to make sure they can obtain decals when required.
9. Points will be awarded as follows:

Overall & classes:	1 st registered competitor	20 points
	2 nd registered competitor	15 points
	3 rd registered competitor	12 points
	4 th registered competitor	10 points
	5 th registered competitor	8 points
	6 th registered competitor	6 points
	7 th registered competitor	5 points
	and so on down to 10 th competitor and all other classified finishers 2 points.	
	All registered competitors who retire from an event will receive 1 point.	

In all categories only the performance of registered competitor relative to one another will be taken into account.

10. Championship positions and points will be published periodically on the Championship web site www.anecccstagerally.co.uk, the onus is in the competitor to report any error or omissions to the Championship Coordinator, within 7 days of publication. Results will be declared final following each round.
11. In the result of a tie, ties will be resolved by referring to the performance of the tied competitors in the first and then succeeding event in which both the competitors started, the competitor scoring the highest points on that round will be deemed the winner. Any tie unresolved in this manner will be decided equitably at the discretion of the Championship Committee (See regulations 13 & 14).

12. The championship will consist of an overall category & five classes for drivers and co-drivers.

- Classes: 1. Up to 1400cc
2. 1401cc to 1600cc
3. 1601cc to 2000cc
4. 2001cc and over
5. All 4WD cars

All turbo and rotary engines will be subject to a capacity loading of 1.7, except diesel powered engines. These classes are not mandatory for the events within the championship.

13. A committee consisting of the coordinator and one representative from each ANECCC Motor Sport Group, together with a representative of the Sponsors, shall have the power to resolve any dispute and to modify these regulations provided that written notification of any change is given to all registered contenders.

14. A panel of Stewards will adjudicate upon any protests arising from these regulations or from the administration of the championship. The members of the panel are: Ronnie Sandham, John Parker, Dave Holliday & Terry Wright.

*Where a National A and National B event are run together the combined results will be used for awarding points.

16. Awards will be made as follows:

1st Co-driver	Brown & Hood trophy & replica
2nd Driver	Sherwoods trophy & replica
2nd Co-driver	Teesside MSG trophy & replica
3rd Driver	Lead Foot trophy & replica
3rd Co-driver	Cumbria MSG trophy & replica

Overall winners are not eligible for class awards. 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class will receive an award (subject to class numbers).

The organisers reserve the right to add additional awards, details of any additional awards will be detailed in the Championship Bulletins.

Please remember that **COMPETITORS MUST START 4 ROUNDS TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR AN AWARD.**

17. The above awards may be augmented at the discretion of the organisers. Trophies remain the property of the ANECCC and will be held for one year or until requested by the Championship Coordinator.
